

## School iPad Return Checklist

Dear 6th and 7th-grade students,

I'm happy to announce that middle school students will be receiving new school iPads for the upcoming school year 2020-2021.

We will be collecting your school-issued iPads on Thursday, June 4th. More detailed information will be sent out by Mrs. Sanchez.

iPad collection checklist:

What to do before my iPad is collected?

- 1. Make sure you have a successful recent <u>iCloud Backup</u> including pictures or documents you would like to keep.
- 2. Make sure Notability is being synced with your Google Drive.
- 3. If you purchased any Kindle books with your school Google account, then log in to your Amazon account and change the email to a personal one. This way, all your purchases are now linked to a personal account and not the school Google account.
- 4. Make sure to **sign out** of your iCloud account-Settings-Tap on your profile picture-tap on the sign-out.
- 5. Make sure to **sign out** of iTunes-Settings-iTunes & App Store-Tap on Apple ID-tap on the sign-out.
- 6. **<u>Remove</u>** passcode to unlock your iPad.
- 7. Do <u>NOT</u> reset your iPad.

What will be collected?



- 1. iPad- Students please remove Otterbox case, this case belongs to you. It fits the 5th and 6th generation iPad.
- 2. Charging Box- It is the white box that plugs into the electrical outlet. (\$20)
- Lightning Cable- It is the white cord that has a lightning connector on one end and a USB Type-A connector on the other end. (\$20)

iPads will be inspected for broken screens and functioning Touch ID, charging port, headphone jack, and front and back camera. Student accounts will be billed for a damaged iPad, missing charging bo, or lightning cable.
