### 8TH GRADE CLASS OF 2020 DIPLOMA EVENT

- Graduates are asked to be dressed in cap and gown, and may wear all academic awards earned during your 8th grade year.
- The tops of Graduation caps may be appropriately decorated. Don't forget to wear your tassel.
- We encourage parents to decorate their cars and be dressed in Jaguar Gear.
- Everyone is asked to remain in their cars due to social distance guidelines and follow the instructions of OLOL staff members.
- All parents are asked to wear masks upon exiting their cars, when instructed by OLOL staff.
- Please open car trunks upon entering the campus to receive items distributed for our graduates.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. On **Wednesday, June 3rd** beginning at 9:45 a.m. until 11:30 a.m., the 8th grade Class of 2020 will drive through the campus with their parents to receive their 8th grade diploma and possibly additional awards.
- 2. Only one car per graduate (siblings/twins together) should enter the campus.
- 3. All friends and family of our graduates are encouraged to watch the historical live streamed event at www.ololourdes.org.

### 4. Graduates whose last names begin with A - I:

- a. All graduates whose last names begin with A I, should arrive at OLOL SW entrance on 142 Avenue by 9:45 a.m. in order to drive through the middle school dismissal line. Cars should line up on the grassy area on 142 Ave. in order of arrival. Cars should be ready to enter the school campus at 9:45 a.m. At which time, staff will be directing you to enter.
- b. OLOL staff will hold up signs indicating the numbers entering. Cars will enter in number order. Please defer to the staff member holding the sign and enter when your child's number is displayed.

c. The personalized sign with your child's name and their assigned number that you received during the pick up and drop off event on 5/28 should be placed on your dashboard.

## 5. Graduates whose last names begin with J - Z:

- a. All graduates whose last names begin with J Z, should arrive at OLOL SW entrance on 142 Avenue by 10:15 a.m., in order to drive through the middle school dismissal line. Cars should line up on the grassy area on 142 Ave. in order of arrival. Cars should be ready to enter the school campus at 10:15 am. At which time, staff will be directing you to enter.
- b. OLOL staff will hold up signs indicating the numbers entering. Cars will enter in number order. Please defer to the staff member holding the sign and enter when your child's number is displayed.
- c. The personalized sign with your child's name and their assigned number that you received during the pick up and drop off event on 5/28 should be placed on your dashboard.
- 6. A parent should drive and the graduate should be seated BEHIND THE DRIVER's seat. If there are graduate siblings or twins, please have them sit next to their sibling in the back seat, as they will exit the car together.
- 7. Upon entering the campus, the graduate will exit the car under the car port at the main entrance of the church. The parents remain in the car and proceed to follow the instructions of the OLOL staff to Spot #2.
- 8. OLOL staff members will direct parents where to stop their car. ONLY 2 parents will be allowed to leave their car parked in "Parents of the Graduate Parking Spot" (see # 2 on the map) in order to enter the church using the side entrance. PLEASE STAY IN YOUR CAR UNTIL A STAFF MEMBER HAS INSTRUCTED YOU TO EXIT. Only 2 parents may exit the car wearing masks and proceed to a designated area as instructed by OLOL staff. These two parents will enter the church to witness their child receiving their diploma. Awards for your graduate will be announced at this time.
- 9. Parents and graduates will return to their cars and continue following the blue arrows to the next Stop #3.

- 10. At Stop #3, parents and the graduate are invited to exit the car and have their photo taken together with the diploma and awards. Please be ready for your photo and do NOT delay the line. Immediately following the photographers' photo, parents and graduates must return to their car, following the instructions of the staff.
- 11. Cars will now follow the WHITE arrows for the grand finale at STOP #4. Please stop your car and have the 8th grade graduate safely stand through your sunroof or out your car window for an aerial photo and/or video. EVERYONE IS TO REMAIN IN THEIR CAR.
- 12. During this drive through, graduates will receive several items from staff members.
- 13. Everyone is asked to remain in their cars due to social distance guidelines.
- 14. We expect the final car to enter our campus on the SW entrance on 142nd Ave. by 10:45 a.m.
